"Rocky River Public Library Celebrates 90th Anniversary" Sunday, November 17th

Rocky River Public Library celebrates its 90th Anniversary on Saturday, November 17 from 11:30 to 3:30 p.m. We welcome the public to spend time exploring the Library and participate in the activates planned throughout the day. Scheduled events include the presentation of a Proclamation by Mayor Pamela E. Bobst, music by Satori Wind Ensemble and the RRHS Jazz Band, Letter Press Craft with The Morgan Conservatory, a photobooth with historic Library images as the backdrop, 3D printer demonstration, light refreshments by Duet Catering and Wild Flour Bakery, and a library-wide scavenger hunt.

The Library was started by the citizens of Rocky River to address their interest in education and cultural works. In 1924, the Rocky River Public Library opened in a second-floor room of the Rocky River Senior High School but quickly outgrew the space. The Library's original structure was made possible through a city bond issue and personal donation from Thomas and Emily Macbeth. Rocky River Public Library opened its doors on November 24, 1928 with a focus on serving our community. With a continued emphasis on patron satisfaction, the Library has found a way to offer traditional services along-side innovative technology, digital materials, and programs for all ages.
