Leila Mottley

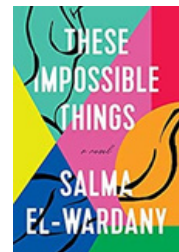

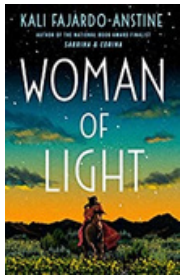

Kali Fajardo-Anstine

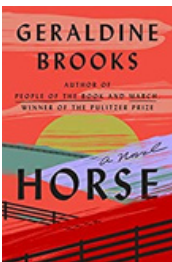

Geraldine Brooks

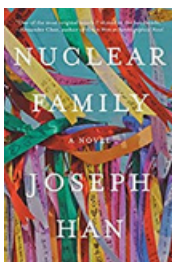

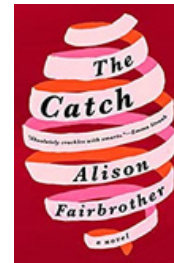
