#### **Viktor Schreckengost**

<u>Viktor Schreckengost (1906-2008)</u> was born into a pottery family in Sebring, Ohio. After graduation from the Cleveland Institute of Art he worked for the Cowan Pottery Studio during its last 18 months (1930-31). His *Jazz Bowl*, created at the Cowan Pottery, remains one of both his and the Cowan Pottery's most famous pieces and became an iconic piece of American Art Deco. Schreckengost's long and illustrious career spanned every form of art and design imaginable. He founded and taught at the Industrial Design Department of the Cleveland Institute of Art for over 70 years.
