SOLICITATION

Category: Operational

Petitioning

1. Individuals or representatives of organizations seeking signatures for petitions for ballot issues, distributing literature or leaflets, or canvassing by members of the public are only permitted outside of the library. Solicitation must not interfere with entering or exiting the library or cause a potentially hazardous situation in the parking lot. Petitioners are asked to notify library staff when they are on library property.
2. As paid representatives of the library, RRPL staff members have an obligation to maintain the political neutrality of the library and will refrain from active or passive campaign activities while on library premises or on library time.

Sales

Panhandling and sales of goods and services by the general public in the library, on the grounds, or in the parking lot are prohibited.
