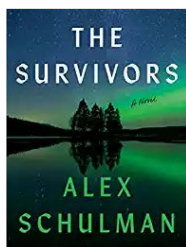
NO ONE WILL MISS HER **KAT ROSENFELD**

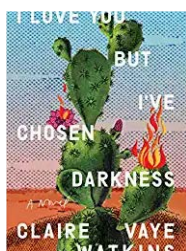
THE LAST CHECKMATE **GABRIELLA SAAB**

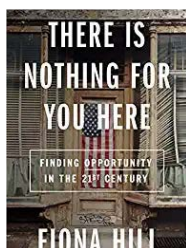

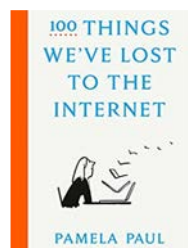
