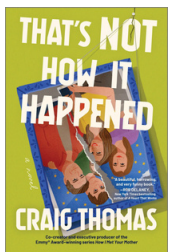
***The Merge* Grace Walker**

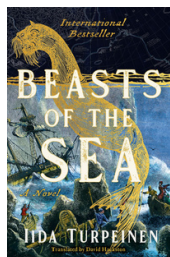
***Bitter Honey* Lolá Ákínmádé Akerström**

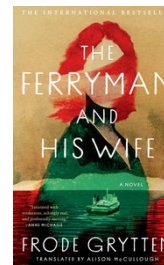
***Other People's Fun* Harriet Lane**
